Joining Instructions

On arrival in the School, you should, along with your child, first report to the New Admissions Reception Counter, register your presence and hand over all pending admission documents to the Admission Staff on duty. Please ensure that these are complete in all respects before they are submitted.

You will then be directed to your child's Housemaster. He/She will send you on to the Hostel Warden, who will check and take over the child's clothing and possessions. Subsequently, we invite you to join us for a special Parents Orientation High Tea, during which, I will introduce you to my staff and familiarize you with the School Mission and its Rules and Regulations and respond personally to any queries that you may have.

All parents will then be expected to depart the same day and will not, under any circumstances, be permitted to meet their children during the first month of the term. There is a sound reason for this and we hope all parents will understand and co-operate.

Children are extremely good at adapting to a new life, provided they are allowed to get on with it, without constant reminders of their homes and parents. You can be sure that they will weather the parting much more easily than you. I know, you will miss your child terribly in the beginning. However, you can rely on us, not only to do the best for your child but also to ensure that they write frequently to you.

Vacation & Visits

Personal Habits & Hygiene

We hope that your child will have been taught at home to bathe themselves, dress neatly, groom their hair, tie their shoelaces and generally look after their own personal hygiene. We would also expect you to have thoroughly inspected their hair for lice and made certain that they do not have any skin or other communicable disease.

Personal Articles & Clothing

I would like to remind you that the clothing list attached with the Admission Documents should be strictly adhered to. No home cloths are allowed except for one Kurta-Payajama set and a warm jacket. Please ensure that you put your child's name and number on each personal item with indelible marking ink,

You must also equip your child with a warm woollen blanket and a quilt preferably packed in a strong nylon or canvas bag.

A steel trunk or strong suitcase should be adequate to contain all his personal belongings. All these should be boldly painted with his name and number.

Your child should also be provided with basic toiletry articles for the term, such as toothpaste, soap, shampoo, sanitary napkins, skin cream, etc. but the use of cosmetics will generally be discouraged. Since we would like them to radiate with natural health from within. The School will arrange to provide them with fresh stocks of these items if their supplies run out.

Necessary text books and stationary are available at the School's Book Store. However, the child may bring along a dictionary, a thesaurus and an atlas although these items will also be available at the School's Book Store.
